

### **Five silver dollar Collection Couplet**

In 1915, Changyu Brandy won the gold medal at the Panama Pacific International Exposition and became famous both domestically and internationally. The winemakers of Changyu successively brewed high-quality products such as KOYA Brandy, Samsung Gold Award Brandy, Venus Gaoyue Brandy, Golden Leaf Double Lion Brandy, Five Star National Soul Brandy, Huayue Brandy, Heyue Brandy, and Gaoyue Brandy, which were highly sought after and loved by consumers at that time. Over the past 100 years, they cultivated a large number of loyal consumers. In the 1930s, a newspaper in Shanghai publicly collected couplets and listed "May Huangmei Tian" as the lower couplet. Those who won the upper couplet were rewarded with 500 silver dollar. Under the heavy reward, the brave men certainly had a pen battle. Unexpectedly, the winning bidder used a wine name to make a couplet, which is the "Three Star Brandy" produced by Changyu Company. Although the meaning may not be in line with the wind, horse, and ox, the neatness of the confrontation is admirable. In order to remember history and trace culture, the Changyu Wine Culture Museum restored and replicated a batch of Changyu's products from the 1930s in 2014, named the "Bogu Fuxin" series, which is very popular among tourists.
