## Changyu Wine City

## ——China's first wine themed amusement park

Since 2012, the construction of Changyu Liquor City located in Yantai Economic and Technological Development Zone has begun, covering an area of 6200 acres.

The architectural features in Changyu Wine City are distinct, serving both production and tourism. The wine production center factory is designed in oak barrels, with a construction area of 220000 square meters. After being fully put into operation, it can produce 250000 tons of wine and 150000 tons of brandy annually.

The Grape and Wine Research Institute is designed in an upright oak barrel shape, with a total of 19 layers, surrounded by several champagne glasses, symbolizing "raising the glass to celebrate". The research institute in Changyu Wine City has a Wine Technology Museum, a center for grapes and wine, product analysis and quality control, and international academic exchanges. The top floor is a sightseeing and wine tasting area.

Tinlot Chateau adopts Gothic architectural style and is built along the lake, covering an area of 20 acres with a building area of 19000 square meters. It has 1000 acres of hillside vineyards and is the first collection level winery in China. Koya Brandy Winery adopts the Romanesque architectural style of medieval Europe, with a building area of 20000 square meters, and is the only professional brandy winery in China.

The tourism project of Changyu Wine City has employed a number of famous experts who once worked as the planning and design personnel of Disneyland and Universal Studios in the United States to plan, create and carefully design.

After the completion of Changyu Wine City, it will become a world-class demonstration area for modern industrial wine production; Grape planting demonstration areas with Chinese origin standards; The characteristic scenic spots of world wine industry tourism; A theme park in the same industry in China that integrates industrial tourism parks, amusement parks, and vineyards.
